Under veterinary supervision and in a supportive environment, you will have the opportunity to experience a typical small animal medical and surgical caseload, with a wide-variety of both wellness and sick pet visits. You will work closely with the team to get histories, perform physical exams, develop differentials, and design/implement diagnostic and treatment plans for the betterment of our valued patients and clients. We will involve you in all aspects of the typical small animal veterinary business and will challenge students to develop their problem-solving and technical skills while encouraging questions and case discussions.
